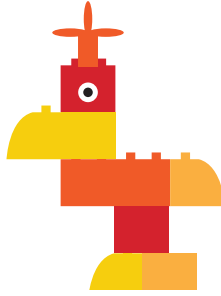


LEGO TRAVEL BOX

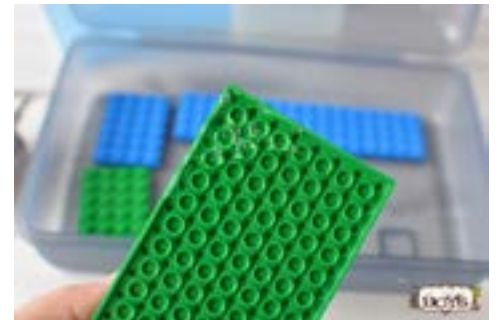
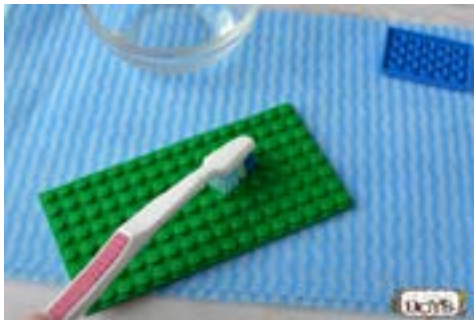
MATERIALS:

- plastic pencil box
- E6000 glue
- LEGO base plates or large pieces
- rubbing alcohol
- old toothbrush



DIRECTIONS:

1. Find a few smaller thin LEGO plates or a larger LEGO base plate that you can cut. Arrange them into a larger rectangle that fits inside your pencil box. I found some green and blue LEGO pieces to create water and land.
2. Wipe the inside and outside of your pencil box with rubbing alcohol. Use an old, clean toothbrush to get into the crevices to remove any dirt, debris and finger prints. Set aside to dry completely.



3. Use an old, clean toothbrush to clean the flat Lego pieces with rubbing alcohol. Removing all dust and debris as well as finger prints. Set aside to dry completely..
4. Place your Lego pieces onto the flat interior surface of the pencil box. I placed mine onto the bottom of the box, because the top had beveled areas and didn't allow all of the pieces to lay flat.
5. Gently pick up one LEGO piece and add a generous amount of E6000 glue to the bottom. Gently press it into the bottom of the pencil box. Repeat until you have the bottom covered. Let set to dry overnight.



6. Add additional LEGO pieces to build and close the box to carry and travel.
