



# Football Cookies

#### **INGREDIENTS:**

2 C. sugar

1/2 C. butter

3 Tbls cocoa

1/2 C. milk

1 tsp vanilla

1/2 C. peanut butter

31/2 C. quick oats



#### **DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. In a large saucepan, bring sugar, butter, cocoa, and milk to a boil for one minute. (Make sure that you don't overcook!)
- 2. Mix in the other ingredients and drop by spoonfuls on waxed paper. To make football cookies, let the cookies cool for a few minutes and then shape into footballs.
- 3. Let cookies cool completely and decorate cookies with frosting in a decorator bag to make the cookies look like footballs. Then enjoy!







## Hot Potato Football Game

#### MATERIALS:

- hot potato game or football
- music

If you buy a Hot Potato game make sure it is a soft one. We have a hard plastic one as well and things don't go so well when kids get throwing it around

#### HOW TO PLAY:

Turn your hot potato into a football with just a little bit of masking tape or use an actual football. A football works best outside.

Players stand in a circle and toss the hot potato to each other while the music plays.

When the music stops, the player holding the football is out. The game continues until only one play is left and is the winner.


You can also use a hula hoop for a target! Hang in a tree and toss the ball through the hoop.


# Football Goal Post
